The main purpose of ASR Inclusion **Coordinator** course is to offer the opportunity to ASRs operators to acquire advanced professional competences in relation to the essential requirements of reception centers across Europe. This will enable them to strenghten their performance in managing and supervising the work within reception centers hosting ASRs and, at the same time, to take responsibility and iniziative to cope with unpredictable changes so as to ensure the effective mastery of processes and procedures needed in the hosting centers.






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
